WATCH DUTY App

Install the "WATCH DUTY" app on your phone to view current incidents and real-time mapping of active wildfires and hazards.

RESIDENTIAL KNOXBOX PROGRAM

San Diego County Fire Protection District Application

The San Diego County Fire Protection District is offering Residential KnoxBoxes to qualified County residents. Under this program, the County will install a lock box at qualified residences to securely store a spare key for emergency use by firefighters.

Eligibility: Residents living in the San Diego County Fire Protection District, **Deer Springs Fire Protection District**, or Ramona Municipal Water District. Applications are reviewed by the County Fire Authority for qualification.

***How it Works:** The steel box simply hangs on top of the door. Firefighters and Paramedics carry a master key to open the box in an emergency, allowing them to enter without breaking down the door.*
